I'm enquiring as to whether there have been any recent discussions to amend this junction to service a potential logistics site of approx 60 hectares on immediately on the north side of the M57 at its junction with the M58. The proposals for the Peel Group are for approx 1000k of logistics facilities have been prepared by NPL planning consultants with TTHC as highway consultants. The scheme is within the green belt and not supported by the local authority shows access being gained from the large and complex "roundabout" at this junction and as a concerned resident i would be glad to know if any discussion has taken place with the consultants on this project. Could I have a response by the end of this month please?

Mr Scott,

Thanks for contacting the Highways England information line.

I exchanged some emails in March 2014 with TTHC. At the time they did not provide me with specific detail on specific size of the development and mentioned only that it would be for warehousing purposes. TTHC had only high level drawings of some proposed access/exit arrangements onto Switch Island.

TTHC were seeking Highways England's agreement in principle to the access/exit arrangements suggested. This 'in-principle agreement' was granted subject to detailed transport assessments and safety audits behind presented as they would be required for any planning application etc at a later stage.

I have not had any contact on this project since then.

Apologies I cannot provide further assistance.
