



‘Our Future, Our Bootle’ is a planning document known as an Area Action Plan which will set out a clear vision for the town for the next two decades and beyond. The plan covers Bootle and parts of Seaforth and Litherland.

The plan will help bring in further investment to the town, creating more opportunities for local people and businesses. It will also help to provide the homes, job opportunities and training, services and transport that people need and want. It will help provide good quality open spaces, improve the local environment and reduce the impact from climate change.

It sets out our approach to:

- Securing good design – buildings, streets and spaces that look good, are easy to look after and function well and safely, now and in the future
- Providing the right number and type of new homes for Bootle, including affordable homes and homes which are cheaper to heat and run
- Restricting inappropriate and poorly designed conversions to flats and homes in multiple occupation
- Improving Bootle Town Centre
- Protecting our most sustainable employment areas and the jobs they provide
- Making sure that developers train and employ local people and help improve skills
- Identifying priority areas for regeneration and redevelopment
- Taking opportunities for development to improve the health of local people
- Keeping and improving Bootle’s parks and open spaces and bringing nature into all new development
- Helping Bootle to deal with the climate emergency.

The Council have published a draft Area Action Plan for comment. This is the second opportunity for people to comment on the Area Action Plan after the first stage during November 2021 to January 2022.
